Fall Semester Registration Open

Registration for the Fall 2010 Semester is now open for all of UoNA's programs. Included are the Master's and Doctoral degrees and the new International Nurse Certification Program (see below). Application forms and program information are available on the university's website at www.uona.us. Fall classes begin on October 9. Programs available are:

- Doctor of Business Administration (DBA)
- Master of Business Administration (MBA)
- Master of Science in Computer Science (MSCS)
- Master of Science in Information Tech. (MSIT)
- Certificate for International Nurses
- English as a Second Language

Start at Home, Finish in the U.S.

Do you know a potential student who wants to earn a U.S. degree but doesn't have the time, money, or visa necessary to come to the United States? These students can complete their programs on-line or begin their programs on-line in their home country and complete them in the U.S. All of the university's Master's and Doctoral degree programs are available on-line and may be completed anywhere in the world. Students may register for either the on-campus or on-line program and switch as their needs change.

Co-operative Education – OPT Available

Remember that students can participate in the Co-operative Education Program at UoNA. This program allows them to work in a job related to their degree program and to earn while they learn and pay for their education at the same time.

International Nurse Training Program

The university has a new program for international nurses. Individuals who are RNs in their home country may join the program and study for six months to become certified to practice in the United States. A successful TOEFL (550) or TOEIC (750) score and GCFNS certification is required. Students complete courses in Professional Development, The Cultures of America, Medical English, and NCLEX-RN Test Preparation. At the end of their training, graduates enter Optional Practical Training (OPT) for one year in an American health care facility. The cost of the program is only \$8,600.

Dual Degree Programs Available

Don't forget that students that who enroll at the University of North America have the option of receiving *two degrees* when they complete their program, one from UoNA and one from Girne American University in North Cyprus. For a small additional fee, students may receive both degrees and participate in graduation ceremonies in both countries. The equivalent degrees that students can earn are:

<u>UoNA Degree</u>	=	<u>GAU Degree</u>
MBA	=	MBA - General
MSIT	=	MBA in MIS
MSCS	=	MSc
DBA	=	PhD
