



Masters, DBA and Doctoral Completion Programs now available on line.

Local students can also attend classes which are taught in a traditional classroom setting in order to interface with faculty and other students for a blended learning experience.

The foundation courses for the Master of Business Administration, Master of Science in Information Technology, and Master of Science in Computer Science degrees are "Business in the Global Environment" and "Technology in the Global Environment." The Global Business course is taught by Jackie Kazanci and the Global Technology course is taught by Linda Beach. Both courses are offered in the class room setting and on line.
